

## THE BAR AT TRAILER H

The 'Fully Stocked Bar' at Trailer H serves a selection of classic and contemporary cocktails, from Martinis and Mojitos to Bones and Rudy Boys as well as a small but perfectly formed selection of 5 whites, 5 reds, 5 rosés, 5 Champagnes and 2 beers.

The bar is co-owned and run by an unrivalled bar team of Soulshakers, Michael Butt (Theme Magazine Bartender of the Year 2003, ex-Match Bar and Sosh) and Giles Looker (ex-Match Bar, Sosh and The Player); the two finest cocktail mariachis in the business. Pete Kendall is the Bar Manager with a mission to ensure a stellar level of service and attention to detail having hung up his ice pick and moved on from the Red Room at Milk & Honey to head up the new joint.

Some differences:

- We charge our water through soda syphons for better, fresher fizzes.
- Our house Gin and Vodka Martinis cost just £4 and are served in smaller 4oz glasses so they remain icy cold to the last little sip. Most martinis are served as triple measures in 7 oz glasses that guarantee the drink gets warm before you can finish it.
- All of our Tiki glassware is shipped from California and we stick rigidly to the original Tiki formulas by sourcing out-of-print recipes and hard-to-find, once-secret ingredients.
- Regulars can buy their own unique, individually-numbered Munktiki shot mug for £10, which is kept at the bar for emergencies and available at all times to dispense quick and delicious hits of potent elixir with a permanent discount.

## TIKI DRINKS

Tiki is back and so are the drinks. Oh yeah daddy-o.

Tiki culture first found its feet in mid-50s America, growing into a phenomenon that lasted well into the late 60s and early 70s. Tiki probably reached its peak between 1955 and 1965, thanks largely to the success of South Pacific (1958), Hawaii joining the union (1959) and the stream of Elvis movies beginning with Blue Hawaii (1961). Tiki drinks and dining injected new hope and optimism into a post-war, cold-war society eager to escape to the bright new future of a space age world of Rock and Doris.

Yesterday's future never came but the drinks and optimism live on at Trailer H - Zombies, Scorpion Bowls and Mai Tais. Strong rum drinks all mixed up with fresh tropical fruit juices and served in Tiki Mugs and Volcano Bowls with flaming Overproof, pineapple garnishes, swizzle sticks and parasols.

We've put together a short but potent list of original classic, and some delicious new Tiki drinks with the help of Cocktail God Dale DeGroff and Tiki Geek Angus Winchester. All of our Tiki drinks are absolutely guaranteed to be dangerous and delicious.

## THE KITCHEN AT TRAILER H

We've got a YAC in the kitchen. Each night, *Young Australian Chef* Cameron Irving (ex Oxo Tower) will be cooking up a selection of delicious nibbles sourced daily from the local market stalls and delis in the H.O.P. (heart of Portobello) all served up fresh from the fridge and the grill by your delightful hosts, Michael and Giles.

Expect to eat: Uncle Leroy's Lamb & Lemon Racks, Alabama Black Snake Sesame Shrimp, Dr. Jay's Green Chilli Fireballs, Trailer Happiness Smokin' Sausage Salsa and Where Have You Been All My Life Crispy Roast Duck? Expect to pay: next to nothing. We won't be going crazy on the prices, to ensure the best value food in the West. £6 for a TV dinner for 1-2 or £9 for 3-4.
